



The 2007 Year 2 Gumshoe 5K Walk solved ...

- 1 **May's** Take the first set of down stairs past the blue building. Whose garden is at the bottom of the stairs?
- 2 **2** Continue on a beeline toward the lake, down the stairs, past the playground, through a gate and down more stairs. At the bottom of the last set of stairs, turn around. Divide the sum of the number of steps with tiles and the number of tiles on the top step by the number of tiles on the bottom step. What's your answer?
- 3 **1917** Continue along the brick building. What year was it built?
- 4 **Green** Continue to the next intersection, carefully cross it and head in the direction the bench faces until you come to Minnie Mouse. What color is the fisherman's boat?
- 5 **\$100** Continue the way you're headed, across the avenue, until the rusty flowers appear on your left. If flowers were \$20 bills, how much would they be worth?
- 6 **Muffin** Continue to the next bunch of rusty flowers. Pass through them and follow the path to the branch leading to the wall frog. Go to the circle where the frog is pointing. What goes with Sparky?
- 7 **Fly On Inn** If Sparky is at 6 o'clock on the circle, exit the circle at approximately 12 o'clock and walk to the first set of stairs. Descend and continue, with Sparky on your left, to the second alley. Turn left into the alley and follow it to the green house at the other end. If you were a bird visiting the green house, where would you stay? (The "Fly On Inn" bird house in the back yard fell down and couldn't be seen during the first days of the walk, so this clue was disallowed for the prize drawing!)
- 8 **Fence** Continue to the avenue and follow it toward the big willow tree. According to the sign near the tree, what would you want built if you dialed either number?
- 9 **Olympic** Continue the way you're headed to the third traffic circle. What foundry made all the SSS covers?
- 10 **Iowa** Cross to the corner with the white chimney and follow the sidewalk up the steep hill. Walk past the stump birdbath to the fire hydrant. Ohio or Iowa?
- 11 **???** Continue in the direction that's 180° from the state side of the hydrant until you reach the ninth house on your right. What would you call the wheel-like thing in the corner of the yard? (The wheel-like thing was removed from the yard by the time the entry forms were printed, so this was another disallowed clue!)
- 12 **Blue** Continue the way you're headed until you come to the house with the flimsy plastic roof. What color is the roof?
- 13 **Bank** Cross to 358, then continue up the steep hill. At 322, in the mushroomed flowerbed: Bank or credit union?
- 14 **Wing** Continue to the top of the hill. Wing or a prayer?

- 15 **Masonry** Turn and walk toward the clock. What is it time for?
- 16 **\$39.95** Continue to the nearest intersection. Cross to get to the leaping dancers, then head in the direction they're leaping until you come to the store with the open bone. How much does the store's Fresh Flow Purifying Water Bowl cost before tax?
- 17 **Stupa** Cross the nearest street (not the avenue), turn left and continue until you come to the big white bell. According to the plaque behind the bell, what is its Sanskrit name?
- 18 **21.6** If the bell plaque is at 6 o'clock, follow the sidewalk that heads off in the direction of 2 o'clock until you see the colorful playground equipment on your right. Multiply the number of red poles by the number of blue slide chutes, then divide the product by the number of little blue stepping stones. What's your answer? (Mr. Gumshoe counted 25 red poles, but there were 27, making the answer harder to figure than intended!)
- 19 **Catholic** Continue toward the nearest steeple, crossing the street in the marked crosswalk but staying on the side of the avenue opposite the steeple. Catholic or Protestant?
- 20 **Kawasaki** Continue the way you were headed to the next traffic circle. Cross diagonally to the corner, then veer left and walk until you come to stone bench in the bank. In the parking/planting strip across from the bench: Suzuki or Kawasaki?
- 21 **4** Continue the way you were headed until you come to the cluster of three gas meters. Divide the number of visible bricks in the nearest arch by the number of visible legs. What's the answer?
- 22 **Appleton** Turn right at the next corner and continue until you can angle right through a building without entering it. Who manufactured the Powertite Receptacle at the end of the building?
- 23 **Cats & Frogs** Continue walking toward the yellow Corey until you come to the green Corey with the yellow top. Turn left and walk until you come to a stateless green Corey with a yellow top. Turn left and walk to 142: Cats or dogs? Fish or frogs?
- 24 **Grasshopper** Continue to the corner, then head past the red awning to the first store under the blue awning. Show this original form to the clerk and you'll get a free bottle of water. Exit the store and cross the avenue to Superman's store. What tophatted insect is gazing at the mirror ball near the cash register?
- 25 **Storytelling** Exit the store and turn left into the next store. What happens here every Friday at 11 am?
- 26 **Hailey** Backtrack across the avenue. With the ice on your left, head in the direction of the "small \$.05" to the next corner and cross the avenue. Turn left and walk to 7015. According to the wall, who's above Annbelle?
- 27 **Cone** Continue to the next corner, turn left across the avenue and go to the next avenue. Head to the nearest marked crosswalk, carefully cross and walk to the business that sells, rents and moves. What is the first squirrel holding?
- 28 **Alright, just fine** Walk past the gallery to the wash. How's Julie Tuesday?
- 29 **Zagat** Continue the way you were headed until you come to the rusty stars. According to the two signs in the window, how is the star business rated?
- 30 **Shaw** Continue the way you were headed, curving left to the tower above the whole community. Whose life belongs to it? Continue to the big blue building.
